Fish 2 Dish is a cross-curricular project for P6-S2 pupils

at Kinlochbervie High School, Durness, Kinlochbervie and

Scourie primary schools. We have previously run similar projects:

2 Dye 4 (2013) , Game On (2014), Place 2 Be (2015) and also Fish 2 Dish in 2012.

Working in groups the pupils will be set a challenge to design, make and promote a fish based ready meal.

The project is in three stages :

Stage One: Friday 11th March Kinlochbervie High School 9am- 3.40 pm

Pupils take part in a series of workshops where they will have the opportunity to engage with local groups and businesses who are involved in the fishing industry.

<u>Stage Two</u>

In their own schools teachers provide background projects about fishing and sustainability to support the learning outcomes of the project. .

Stage Three: 5th/6th May Kinlochbervie High School 9am- 3.40 pm

This will involve an 'apprentice' style group challenge to develop, make and market a fish based ready meal. Groups will present their products on **Friday 6th May at 2pm** and you are invited to come along.

Learning Outcomes for Fish 2 Dish

- > Develop and use problem-solving strategies to meet a design challenge.
- Set up and operate as a mini business, collaborating with their group in deciding and taking on varying roles and responsibilities
- > Develop social skills by working a presenting a joint project
- > Appreciate the role local business has in the local economy
- > Develop an awareness of possible career opportunities in the local area
