Languages: In our imaginative writing lessons we will be learning to write realistic stories where the main character has a problem or a dilemma to solve. Our core reading lessons will involve examining the features of realistic stories. In reading we will be developing our comprehension skills through non-fiction texts.

It's election time! So we will be learning how to prepare balanced arguments and write persuasive texts. This will lead onto powerful poetry writing!

## Sciences:

We will be looking at local habitats to identify herbivores, carnivores and omnivores. We will be learning how to explain the difference between a food chain and a food web.

We will be contributing to the design of a wildlife area in our school grounds. We will be growing a variety of edible plants and learning all about the importance of micro-organisms in composting. We will be learning about the parts of a plant and finding out about pollination.

## Expressive Art

As part of our school grounds project we will be making lots of environmental artworks using recycled materials. We will be continuing with our weekly music lessons with Miss Lockhart

## RME:

We will be listening and reflecting upon biblical and other Christian stories, with Dion the minister. We will be considering the importance of values such as honesty, respect and compassion through a variety of stories.

P5-7 Class: Term 4 /2017 Curriculum Areas

<u>Maths:</u> Algebra and data handling: We will be learning how to choose the <u>best strategy</u> for solving mental and written calculations including equations and word problems. Look out for *chunking*, *grid methods* and *jumping number lines* as we re-visit these strategies.! We will be discussing the most <u>efficient method</u> to choose for a particular problem.

In practical maths we will be learning how to display data in a clear way using a suitable scale, creating tables, charts, diagrams and graphs, making effective use of technology to do this.

## Renew Refresh Repair

<u>HWB</u> This term provides many opportunities to make friends and be part of a group in a range of situations. We will be using the Resilient Kids programme.

Through team games; rounders, cricket and outdoor games we will learn about the importance of participation, inclusion, strategy and encouragement. In athletics we will be trying to improve our individual performance in track and field events. We also have four swimming lessons.

<u>Social Studies:</u> We will be learning about different groups in our community and how they are organised. We will be focussing on our own school community as we look to develop our outdoor space. We will need to carry out an audit and survey to find out what our improvement needs are.

<u>Technologies</u> In data handling we will be learning how to use <u>spreadsheets</u> and present data using a variety of computer generated graphs using the 'excel' programme. We will be learning how to use tools and equipment in order to carry out a task safely. We will find out about a range of methods to join and strengthen materials.

We will be estimating and measuring accurately using appropriate units and tools.
