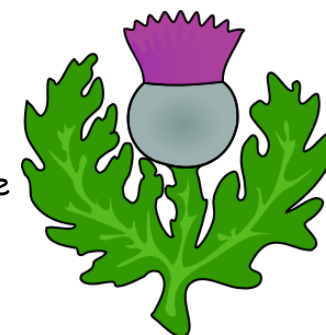


Homework Grid : Term 3 Scotland
