#### Languages:

Our core reading lessons will be on historical fiction with a WW2 theme. We also have a book study: Carrie's War. We will be using non-fiction books for research to select information. In writing we will be writing journals and recounts for our characters. We will be creating different functional texts like posters and instructions.

## <u>HWB</u>

The focus for PE this term is football and hockey. Through our classroom routines and methods of working together in a co-operative, respectful manner we will be trying to become more confident, more included and more relaxed. We hope this will result in better peer relationships, with more awareness of other's feeling and help us to manage our own feelings.

## Expressive Arts:
