



Here is your choice of homework tasks. From the nine activities below, you need to choose 3 to complete for this term. You will have **2 weeks** to complete each task, so the expectation is that you will put in **care** and **effort** and complete it to the best of your ability. You can present your work in an appropriate style of your choice - a poster, model, booklet, diagram, leaflet etc. and it may be word-processed or completed by hand.



<p>Propaganda Poster or a T shirt Create a slogan and poster/T Shirt to encourage people to: dig for food, keep secrets, join the army, keeping the lights off, saving food etc.</p>	<p>Poetry- Write a poem about WW2. You could write about the Blitz, life in the air raid shelter, being evacuated or rationing.</p>	<p>Forces: Make an information page about the soldiers of WW2 or planes, tanks, warships, Include: title, opening paragraph, diagrams , labels, headings,</p>
<p>War Vehicles - Make a model of a German or British war vehicle from the 2nd World War. Think about colour, design, materials and structure. You could make a model plane, a U Boat or a landing craft.</p>	<p>WW2 food -Research the wartime food. What sort of food did they eat? Why not try to cook a WW2 recipe? Don't forget to take a photo or bring some in for us to taste! Write up the recipe in your jotter.</p>	<p>WW2 in Sutherland Be a history detective...find evidence of WW2 around our local area. Take photos and write a caption to say what you have found...there is lots to find! ...Find out about HMS Hood and what happened in Loch Eribol in 1945</p>
<p>Time Line: Make an illustrated time-line for WW2. Include the main events you think our class would be interested in.</p>	<p>Interview Ask an elderly relative or friend about their experience of the war. Write up your interview notes. OR Artefact Can you find anything from the time of the WW2? Draw and label, or take a photo and add a caption to explain what it is and how you found it.</p>	<p>Read all about it - Write a newspaper article which could have gone out on the day that the Prime Minister announced Britain was at war or about the Blitz. Think about headlines, sub headings, photos, captions, columns, quotes, past tense, conclusions etc.</p>
