#### AMOUNT OF ASSISTANCE FOR SCHOOL CLOTHING

For eligible applications received up until 1st July 2016: - Only one payment per pupil per school year is paid

£81 per pupil

#### Please Note:

A new Application needs to be submitted for the start of every new school session in August.

Successful applications meeting the criteria for eligibility will be entitled to receive Free School Meals and Assistance with School Clothing for each school pupil. Application forms for academic year 2016-17 will be available from June 2016.

- Free School Meals will be effective immediately and the applicant will be advised in writing.
- Clothing Grant Payments will be made by Paypoint cash voucher which you can receive by sms text or email, or a hardcopy voucher can be posted out to you. To redeem the voucher you simply present it at any PayPoint outlet.
- Payment is made directly to the applicant for the sum of £81 for every eligible child in Primary or Secondary school.
- Payment for assistance with school clothing will be issued from <u>July 2015 onwards</u>.

Should your circumstances change that affect your entitlement, you must inform the council's catering services immediately.
